Objectives

Underlying Principles



No land acquisition

Land ownership remains with farmers; only a carbon waiver agreement is required for project activities.



Biodiversity focus

Multiple region-suited species are planted to promote healthier ecosystems.



Community partnership

Nurseries, land preparation, sapling supply, fencing and training are carried out with active involvement of local communities.



Long-term commitment

The project spans 40 years, during which farmers receive revenue shares, Tasar Sericulture income (from Year 4+) and, at maturity, 100% timber value from the trees.





Key Focus Areas



Investment in irrigation and water harvesting structure creation to create multiple income streams.



Strengthening value chains for Tasar and millet-based commodities through improved inputs, technology and market linkages, including support from FPOs.



Community participation in planning and management, with social audits to ensure transparency and shared benefits.



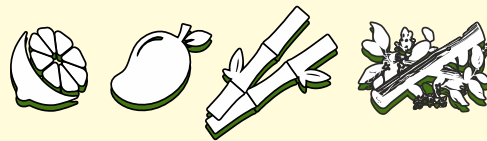
Supporting women's roles in nursery raising, Tasar rearing and other economic activities

Responsibilities of Landowners

- Plant and protect saplings as per farm designs developed with the project team.
- Ensure the land is not enrolled in other carbon or NRM projects.
- Prevent grazing within the plantation; fencing & trench making support will be provided.
- Follow advisories on sapling care, land preparation and soil and water conservation.
- Avoid tree harvesting during the 40-year project period; collection of Arjuna leaves and fruit will be managed jointly with the project team.
